System Requirements

This section describes the software and hardware necessary to install and run Gimmal Contract Management.

Required Documentum Software Versions

Gimmal Contract Management Version 6.9.1 is certified to operate with the following Documentum versions:

- Documentum Administrator Version 7.2
- Content Server Version 7.2
- Documentum Administrator Version 6.7 SP2
- Content Server Version 6.7 SP2

NOTE: As of April 2015, version 6.7 SP2 of Documentum Administrator and Content Server are only supported with the EMC Extended Support Plan.

Optional Supported Documentum Products

- Documentum Rendition Services
- Documentum Reporting Services
- Documentum Index Server (Documentum xPlore)

Deployment Requirements

Gimmal Contract Management Version 6.9.1 requires DAR Deployer 6.7 SP2 Patch 21 or later for the installation of the required Documentum Archive (dar) files.

Hardware

Gimmal software products are deployed on an existing or new Documentum environment leveraging existing or planned infrastructure investments. No additional hardware is required.

Enhancements

My Tasks

In order to more clearly distinguish original tasks from their associated reminder tasks that are sent based on the **Notification Resend Interval** system parameter. A new link named **Show/Hide Resend Notifications** has been added to the Actions bar. Clicking the **Hide Resend Notifications** link will filter the Tasks list to only show the original tasks, thus hiding any tasks that are just reminders. After clicking the **Hide Resend Notifications** link, the text should change to **Show Resend Notifications**. Clicking the **Show Resend Notifications** link will display all Tasks and Resend Notifications.





Figure 1 – Resend Notifications Hidden



Added Job Parameter for Notification Email Address

Added support for the following parameter to the **IM_ProcessMonitor** job. Please refer to the *Gimmal Contract Management v6.9.1 Installation and Maintenance Manual* for information on using this parameter.

notificationEmail

If specified, any errors encountered during the execution of the job will be sent to the designated email address. If sending to multiple email addresses, they should be separated by a semicolon.

Examples:

Single email address:	-notificationEmail joe.smith@acme.com
Multiple email addresses:	-notificationEmail joe.smith@acme.com; jane.doe@acmecorp.com

Added support for the following parameters to the **IM_RenderPDF** job:

notificationEmail

If specified, any errors encountered during the execution of the job will be sent to the designated email address. If sending to multiple email addresses, they should be separated by a semicolon.

Examples:

Single email address:	-notificationEmail joe.smith@acme.com
Multiple email addresses:	-notificationEmail joe.smith@acme.com; jane.doe@acmecorp.com

batchSize

Allows an administrator to specify the number of nontext PDF files to be sent to the OCR processing engine. If not specified, the system defaults to 10.

Examples:

Batch size of 20	-batchSize 20
Batch size of 75	-batchSize 75

Enhanced the Document Import Utility

Added support for the following parameters to the **IM_DocumentImportUtility** document import job. Please refer to the *Gimmal Contract Management v6.9.1 Installation and Maintenance Manual* for information on using this parameter.

notificationEmail

If specified, a summary email of the import job is sent to the designated email address. If sending to multiple email addresses, the parameters should be separated by a semicolon.

Examples:

Single email address:	-notificationEmail joe.smith@acme.com
Multiple email addresses:	-notificationEmail joe.smith@acme.com; jane.doe@acmecorp.com

senderEmail

If specified, the summary email is sent from this email address. If the argument is not specified, the email defaults to the email address of the Installation Owner.

Examples:

Email address:	-senderEmail	dctmadmin@acme.com
----------------	--------------	--------------------

fieldDelimiter

This parameter specifies the delimiter that is used to separate the data fields in the input file. If the argument is not specified, the delimiter defaults to **tab**. Valid values are:

- tab Indicates the data items in the input file separated by a tab character
- comma Indicates the data items in the input file are separated by a comma (,)
- **pipe** Indicates the data items in the input file are separated by the pipe (|) character

Examples:

Comma	-fieldDelimiter comma
	-fieldDelimiter Comma
Tab	-fieldDelimiter tab
	-fieldDelimiter TAB
Pipe	-fieldDelimiter pipe
,	-fieldDelimiter Pipe

repeatDelimiter

This parameter specifies the delimiter that is used to separate repeating data fields in the input file. If the argument is not specified, the delimiter defaults to **pipe**. The **fieldDelimiter** and **repeatDelimiter** values must be set to different values. Valid values are:

- **pipe** Indicates the data items in repeating fields in the input file are separated by the pipe () character
- **comma** Indicates the data items in repeating in the input file are separated by a comma (.)
- **tab** Indicates the data items in repeating fields in the input file separated by a tab character

Examples:



View Locations Page Updated

The links on the left hand side of the **View Locations** page provided the same navigation as clicking the **Go To Location** link on the right, but they were not as reliable. The screen captures below show the comparison between Gimmal Contract Management 6.9.0 and Gimmal Contract Management 6.9.1.

- 1. Added the **Document Name** next to the Items Per Page dropdown
- 2. Removed links from the left side of the page and changed the Path to be on a single line





Reports from Document Dashboard

Restricting a Report to a Particular Document Type

The **Properties Page Report** setting in the **Edit Settings | Report** tab now allows a report to be restricted to a single document type. The format is document Type | ReportName. For example, to restrict the **Assigned Tasks Complete** Crystal report to be visible only on the Document Dashboard for General Agreements, you would enter the following in the Properties Page Report:

general agreement|Assigned Tasks Complete

NOTE: There is no space between the document type, the pipe symbol, and the report name.




Figure 2 - Edit Settings | Properties Page Report




Figure 3 - Properties Page Report on Jacket Document Dashboard

Displaying a Different Crystal Report on Datagrids

A new property named **Datagrid Page Report** allows for a different Crystal report to be displayed on the Datagrid.




Figure 4 -Edit Settings | Datagrid Page Report




Figure 5 - Datagrid Report from Document Dashboard

Allow a Horizontal line to Be Configured on a Jacket

With the previous Jacket configuration you could only add a blue separator with text. Now you can add lines on a Jacket, which allows improved grouping of related fields.




Figure 6 - Configuring a Jacket to Display a Horizontal Line




Figure 7 - Example Jacket Configuration with a Horizontal Line




Figure 6 - Jacket Configuration to Display a Horizontal Line

Datagrid Enhancements

See the items below for the enhancements and bug fixes related to Datagrids:

- When entering data into a text, number, or currency field and pressing the Enter key, your changes are no longer lost.
- The display order of dependent Datagrids can now be specified by setting the **Datagrid Sequence** value when configuring the Datagrid.
- The default height of a Datagrid can now be specified by setting the **Datagrid Height** value when configuring the Datagrid.
 - o If a value is not specified for the Datagrid Height, approximately 8 rows will be displayed on the Datagrid without scrollbars.

- For example, if you only want 3 visible rows on a Datagrid, set the **Datagrid** Height to 11em (each row is equal to approximately 3em and the header row is 2em).
- The **Datagrid Height** value also accepts **px** as a unit specifier if you need to finetune the Datagrid.
- Automated Reminders can be created for Datagrids that contain at least one date field.
- The date value in a Date field can now be deleted.
- You can now enter a date in many formats with the keyboard in a Date field instead of having to use the Date Picker.




Figure 9 - Enter Date in Date Field

Datatable Enhancements

The following enhancements were added to Datatables:

- Datatables can now be configured to populate fields with a default value when a new row is added.
- Lookup fields on Datatables now allow TextArea and Dropdown field dependencies and filters.




Figure 10 – Improved Lookup Fields

Advanced Property Mapping

Additional system parameters have been added that allow for Property fields to be copied to other fields while transforming the values.


PropertyMap - Repeating Properties Formatted with a Separator to a Single Property

The PropertyMap system parameter allows you to take the values from repeating property fields and copy to a single property on a document. The name of the parameter must begin with PropertyMap followed by a unique descriptor (for example, PropertyMapContact, PropertyMap1, etc.).

Parameter Value: <object_type>|<order(asc
desc)>|<separator>|<source(repeating attribute>|<target attribute on
document>

Example: Copy all of the Contact First Name (im_firstname) repeating fields to the Contract Managers (im_contractmanagers) field separated by a comma and sort the values in ascending order.



Example: Copy the values from the Category (c_category) field on the Service Agreement Datagrid to the Project Description (im_projectdecription) field separated by a dash and sort the values descending.

ConcatenateMap - Multiple Single Value Properties Formatted to a Single Property

The ConcatenateMap system parameter allows you to concatenate multiple properties to a single property on a document. The name of the parameter must begin with ConcatenateMap, followed by a unique descriptor (for example, ConcatenateMapContact, ConcatenateMap1, etc)

Parameter Value: <object_type>|<formatter (%1 %2>|<source(comma-separated
single attributes>|<target attribute on document>

Example: Concatenate the FirstName (im_firstname) and LastName (im_lastname) fields to the FullName (im_fullname) field for the Service Agreement (service_agreement) document type in **LastName**, **FirstName** format.

Parameter Name:	ConcatenateMapContact
Parameter Value:	service_agreement %1, %1 im_lastname,im_firstname im_fullname

AutoLink documents to multiple locations

DynamicLinkingMap and DynamicLinkingRule — Allows for a single copy of a document to be filed to multiple folders

The DynamicLinkingMap System Parameter is similar to the **Auto File** Rules, but it creates link(s) to the original document, thus the document can be located in multiple folders. The name of the parameter must begin with DynamicLinkingMap followed by a unique descriptor (i.e. DynamicLinkingMapStatus, DynamicLinkingMap1, etc)

Parameter Value: <object_type>|<root path>|<format(%s<> static, %t<>
document, %d<>datagrid|<static values(comma separated)|<document
property(comma separated)>|<datagrid columns(<grid_name>.<grid_column>
comma separated must be in hierarchy order)

The DynamicLinkingRule System Parameter is required for the DynamicLinkingMap to be executed. The name of the parameter must begin with DynamicLinkingRule followed by a unique descriptor (i.e. DynamicLinkingRuleStatus, DynamicLinkingRule1, etc)

Parameter Value: <object_type>|<dynamiclinkingmap name>|<optional: query
predicate>
